

## Enunciate

The “enunciate” feature allows a dispatcher to be alerted when selected individuals are talking.

### **Example:**

A police department dispatcher wants to be alerted any time that the chief of police is talking on the radio. Using Enunciate, whenever the C Plus decodes the chief’s radio ID, the C Plus will sound a preselected series of beeps.

Sample Alias table line with enunciate:

```
00001258,CHIEF 58,Chief Bob Smith,4
```

In this example, Chief Bob Smith has radio ID 1258. Whenever his ANI is received, the C Plus III main display will show CHIEF 58. The assignment field of the secondary display will show Chief Bob Smith. The C Plus sounder will beep rapidly four times, alerting the dispatcher that Chief Smith is talking.

### **Special Requirements:**

The optional feature “Alias” must be purchased and activated. Contact Cimarron Technologies for information.

### **Additional Information:**

The beep field in the above example is set to “4”. It can contain a number between 0 and 5. If set at zero, the associated ID will not cause the C Plus to beep. If set to one, the beep configuration is as described in the C Plus message table. A number between 2 and 5 reflects the quantity of rapid single beeps the C Plus will sound when a PTT ANI is received from the radio with the associated ID.
